Frankfurt (Established in 2007)

Located in Frankfurt am Main, the campus lies in the Sachsenhausen district, close to the South Railway Station and just two U-Bahn stops from the city centre. As Germany's major financial metropolis—often called “Mainhattan”—it offers students excellent exposure to banking, finance, and service industries, as well as strong opportunities in IT, biotech, and logistics.

Munich (Established in 2009)

Admission Process

Program Duration and Format

- 9 Months Hybrid - Amity University Online
- 12 Months - On Campus at International School of Management, Germany

Program Fee Course

- Amity Online Study Abroad Program - ₹3,50,000
- On Campus M.Sc - Business Intelligence and Data Science at International School of Management - €9,460

Eligibility Criteria

- Students with a 3- /4- year bachelor's degree with a minimum 55% or above marks during their Undergraduate study.
- Student should have obtained at least 15 credits in the field of business (eg, Business administration, economics, business information systems or related fields). Of those credits, at least 10 credits must have been earned in quantitative courses (eg, math, statistics, computer science, technology, market research, econometrics or related fields). Qualified professional experience, both in business and in the quantitative field, can be used to compensate for a lack of subject specific ECTS points
- General BA/ General B.Sc. degrees (without specialisation) are not acceptable.
- A bachelor's degree awarding university/institute should be H+. To check H+ please visit https://anabin.kmk.org/no_cache/filter/institutionen.html
- English Proficiency score- IELTS 6.5, TOEFL(iBT)-80 or PTE- 67
- Transfer Criteria - To successfully transition into the M.Sc Year 2 program at ISM, students must score an aggregate of 50% and above in the first-year coursework done at Amity University Online, with a minimum of 50% in each course



Selection Process

Step 1: Application, Screening & Seat Blocking

Fill out the application form online. Our admissions committee will screen your profile to check eligibility. You will be required to pay INR 20,000 to block your seat.

Step 2: Receive Your Offer Letter

Upon qualifying the profile screening and confirming your seat block, an official Offer Letter will be sent to you confirming your selection for the program.

Step 3: Complete Full Payment & Start Course

To finalize your admission, pay the remaining full balance of the program fee. You will gain access to the prep course and start your journey only after the full payment is completed.
